

Note #1

CHEM 100 fulfills all requirements for the chemistry major and minor and prepares students for CHEM 102, just like CHEM 101, but includes a greater emphasis on introductory concepts and problem solving.

Note #2

Students who have passed one or more chemistry placement exams can apply for lab waivers. Applications for lab waivers will *not* be evaluated unless a student has passed one of the departmental placement exams.

Note #3

Students with very strong high school preparation in chemistry and math (typically with a chemistry A.P. score of 5 and co-enrollment in MATH 114 or higher) may also consider taking CHEM 115 and 116, Honors General Chemistry.
